

Just take a picture of “before” and walk the runway in the “after”!

- Items to restyle, recycle and re-use may be purchased from a rummage sale, yard sale, Goodwill or other second-hand/thrift shop or “found” in the back of a closet. You must have a “before” picture of every item you use!
- At least 75% of the finished look must be from second-hand items, but you may cut, sew, combine, and embellish in any way and with anything you want! (Sewing machines and assistance will be available at Scarborough Church by appointment starting November 1st, or as needed.)
- Contestants must model their new outfit at the Project Greenway show on November 9th, and be prepared to share the story of where they got their items, and what they did with them. You must arrive by 2:30 p.m. on the day of the show.
- Judging will be based on wearability, inspiration, and transformation plus the “wow” factor. Judges donating their time include fashion-savvy women from March Boutique, Adrianna Papell, Inc. and Gingko NY Jewelry.
- You must complete an entry form by **November 1, 2014** with your “before” photo. There is no cost to enter.
- Categories for judging include: “Under 19 years”, “19 years and up”, and “Best in Show.” Cash prizes in all categories.
